Bind-R can be used where the addition of a sticker, spreader or deposit agent is required or recommended on the agricultural chemical label.

RATES OF APPLICATION

Use Bind-R at a rate of 0.1% dilution of the final water volume in the spray tank (see example chart). If spraying conditions indicate impending rainfall or irrigation, the Bind-R should be used at a rate to give 0.14% dilution of the final water volume in the spray tank.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Bind-R is a true sticker, extender providing superior sticking abilities and extending the life of your agricultural chemical and helps regulate droplet size and reduce drift, allowing a uniform spray pattern.

MIXING

Half fill the spray tank with water and commence agitation. Add the required amount of agricultural chemical. Top up the tank and then add the required quantity of Bind-R. Continue agitation while topping up the tank during spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of reach of children. Store in closed, original container in a well ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or, preferably, pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots.

Empty containers and product should not be burnt

Refillable containers: Empty containers fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to point of supply for refill or storage.
